March Update on our new Building

Over the past few months things have progressed on our new outside building. Bill Montelbano has finalized the plans for our four season building.

Last fall we began the search for large white pine logs. Some of these logs came from Northern Wisconsin and others from Illinois. These logs were cut into required measurements by Dan Watts and allowed to dry over winter. Beginning March 8th we've been cutting, planing, sanding, staining and assembling these massive timbers that will be the focal point of our new building. Work was directed by Dan Watts. His volunteer crew consisted of Don Parrell, Dave Haugen, Paul Skalet, Dennis Schafer, Gary Olsen, Dale Paddock, Bo Olsen, Steve Fields, Harald Norslien, Jeff Herrling, Earl Brandt, Dave Dybdahl, Jim Festge, Jon Urness, Arlyn McKenzie, Greg Herrling and Pastor Chad. Gary took a number of pictures of the volunteers in action and you can see them on our Vermont's Website. Each day the group was served lunch by Donna, Tee, Joan Skalet or Patty. Paul Dybdahl stopped by to help with the material selection and color coordination.

Starting the week of March 22nd we will be breaking ground and starting construction of our new building and improved kitchen access. The beginning of April we will receive 220 18' long tongue and groove white pine ceiling boards which will need touch up sanding and staining. Bob Laufenberg, our lead carpenter, is working with Marling Lumber Co. purchasing our building materials. The volunteer lunch and meeting held on March 20th was attended by 50 members. Their comments, suggestions, enthusiasm, and their willingness to help is gratifying and a sure sign of a healthy church.

We are fortunate Terry Doyle will once again volunteer his time to handle the electrical part of the building, and Shaun Lynch will volunteer his time as the mason. Bob has offered to work many Saturdays as more volunteers will be available. As you come to Church on Sunday—stop and look at the progress—you, then, will find a perfect spot for your expert volunteer help! Let Greg Herrling know when you will be available.
